MAX A. GORS

Funeral services were held in the Bethany Lutheran Church for Max Gors on Monday, June 20th, at 2 o'clock. The interment took place at the West cemetery. A quartette composed of Mrs. Vernon Kaarup, Mrs. Alphie Petersen, Johnnie Andersen and Earl Fletcher sang two selections. Eloise Petersen was the pianist and Rev. Holger Berthelsen officiated as pastor.

Four grandsons and two nephews were pallbearers: Richard Gors, Lester Gors, Eugene Hollman, Harold Hollman, Royal Paulsen and Lyle Paulsen. Viborg Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.

Max A. Gors passed away June 15th, 1949, at the age of 83 years, 8 months, and 5 days.

He was born in Straslund, Germany, on October 10th, 1865, and came to America with his parents, settling in Clinton, Ia. Later they came to South Dakota in the year 1878, and settled in Turner County.

In 1887 he was united in marriage to Marietta Shelly. To this union four children were born, all of whom have preceded him in death.

In 1902 he was united in marriage to Annie Paulson. To this union four children were born. One of them, a daughter, passed away in infancy.

On August 22, 1926, he became a member of the Bethany Lutheran Church, having transferred from Mt. Zion Lutheran Church.
