Jens Kanstrup passed away at 1:00 o'clock this morning at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Peter Lauritsen, where he has been making his home for a time.

Mr. Kanstrup has been in ill health for some time, and has been to different places and has tried many doctors and specialists in order to regain his health, but nothing could be done for him and he got weaker as time went until the end came.

Funeral services will be held next Monday from the South Lutheran church, and interment will be made in the Rose Hill cemetery, besides his two children, who died several years ago.

Funeral Services Held Mon-

Jens Christian Petersen Kanstrup, was born April 24, 1863, in Easterbou, near Aalborg, Denmark, and passed away on November 25th, 1925, at the age of 62 years, 6 months and 29 days.

Mr. Kanstrup was united in marriage to Kristin Lauritsen on April 11, 1887. To this union nine children were born, three of whom have preceded him in death. Four boys and two girls are still living to mourn his death, namely: John, of Viborg; Peter, Jack and Joe, of California; two daughters, Mrs. R. L. Smith and Mrs. Leo Cleasen, of Omaha, Neb.

Mr. Kanstrup came to America in 1894, and has been a resident of Viborg most of the time since his coming to this country. For a time he was in business in Askov, Minn., and later went to Oregon, where he spent about a year, but when his health began to fail he came back to Viborg, and he tried many specialists in order to regain his health, but of no avail.

Funeral services were held from the home of John Kanstrup and the South Lutheran church on Monday, November 30th, and interment was made in Rose Hill cemetery, Rev. J. J. Lerager conducting the services.
