FUNERAL SERVICES FOR ART PETERSON HELD WEDNESDAY

Funeral services for Art Peterson were held Wednesday, March 13, at 2:00 P.M., from the Viborg Methodist Church with Rev. Edgar S. Farnsworth officiating.
