Mrs. Hannah Pederson was born in Aalborg, Denmark, September 3, 1840, and passed away November 19, 1925, at the age of 85 years and 2 months.

Mrs. Pedersen joined the Baptist church in Denmark in her young age.

In 1865 she was united in marriage to Andreas Hansen. Mr. Hansen died in January, 1878, being only about 38 years old.

In 1887 Mrs. Pedersen came to this country together with her children and settled in Daneville, Turner county, South Dakota. In 1890 she was married to Hans Pedersen. She had been in poor health for several years and for that reason she was compelled to make her home with her daughter, Mrs. J. P. Nelson for the last three years. Her last illness of two weeks duration ended quietly in the last long sleep.

To her first marriage was born seven children, four boys and three girls, one boy and one girls died in infancy, the other five children are Emil Hansen, Centerville, S. D., Harry M. Hansen, of Montley, Minn., Mrs. P. C. Christiansen, of Irene, Mrs. J. P. Nelson, of Viborg, and Martin A. Hansen, of Philbrock, Minn. Twenty-seven grandchildren and seventeen great-grandchildren, together with one brother, Christian Christiansen, West Branch, Iowa, many relatives and a great company of friends mourn the loss of this loved one.
