Alice Amelia Larsen Nelson was born May 27, 1924 at Beresford. Her parents were Adolph and Florence (Anderson) Johnson.

She attended school in Centerville and graduated from high school in Beresford. She worked as a nanny in Chicago until her marriage to Rolland Larsen on June 19, 1943. They worked in an airplane factory in Wichita Falls, KS during the war. They moved to Viborg where Alice worked for Dr. Ronald Lockwood, DVM and as dental assistant for Dr. Harmon Kier. She was most known for her many years as a nurse's aid at Pioneer Memorial Hospital until her retirement in the early 1990's due to the loss of her sight. She married Palmer Nelson on November 9, 1979 at Dalesburg Lutheran Church in rural Beresford. They lived on a farm for 11 years before moving into Beresford.

Alice passed away on October 21, 1997 at Sioux Valley Hospital in Sioux Falls. She had attained the age of 73.

She was preceded in death by her parents, an infant brother, and her first husband Rolland.

Alice is survived by her husband Palmer of Beresford; 2 daughters Debora and husband Paul Dangel and Carla and husband James Hybertson both of Viborg; 2 step-children Craig Nelson of Beresford and Jolene Nelson of Minneapolis; 4 grandchildren Amanda and Megan Dangel and Jared and Jordon Hybertson; 3 step-grandchildren Rachel, Daniel and Hannah Nelson; 2 brothers Glen A.
