**MRS. BUCK, PIONEER  
PASSES TO HER REWARD**

Kristine Magdalene (Johnsen) Buck was born May 29, 1862 in Redsted Mors, Denmark. She immigrated to America in the spring of 1888, at which time she was married to Peder Christensen Buck, the date being April 28, 1888. The marriage took place in New York City, with Rev. R. Andersen as officiating pastor. Andersen was at that time connected with the seamen's mission. Following this the young couple proceeded to Hurley, So. Dak., to the home of a brother-in-law, who was then farming in the Hurley community. They lived with this man for several years until Peder Buck was able to buy himself a piece of land at Center Point, S. D. At this place they lived almost the remainder of their lives. Mr. Buck passing away on Jan. 12, 1920.

Mrs. Buck moved to Viborg from Center Point in 1925, where she died in her little home in the southeast part of town on April 26, 1936, at the age of 74 years, 10 months and 27 days.

To the union of these two people seven children were born, five of whom passed away as infants. The two children who remain to mourn the loss of their mother are: Mrs. Niels Jespersen and John Buck, both of the Viborg community. Two children of a former marriage of Peder Buck are Mrs. Christine Miller and Lars Beck of Tyler, Minn.

Funeral services were conducted from the home at 1:00 o'clock, and our Savior Danish Lutheran church at 1:30 o'clock on April 28, 1936, this day being the 48th anniversary of the marriage of the deceased. Interment was on Spring Valley Lutheran cemetery. Rev. Harris Jespersen, the officiating Pastor. Blessed be the memory of Mrs. Buck.
