SPINAL MENINGITIS CAUSE OF DEATH

Leaves Four Sisters and
Three Brothers to
Mourn

Luella Hedevig Madsen was born on September 18th, 1893, on the farm one mile east of Viborg, and died on April 16th, 1923, at Sioux City, Iowa, at the age of 29 years, 6 months and 28 days.

Luella Madsen has been residing in Sioux City for a number of years, and of late had been suffering from Spinal Meningitis. She was well known in this vicinity, having made her home here prior to going to Sioux City.
