Funeral Held For Herbert L. Peterson

Funeral service for Herbert L. Peterson was held Tuesday, October 30, 1990, at Viborg United Methodist Church with Pastor Greg Kroger officiating. Organist was Mrs. Alphonse Peterson. Herbert Lyle Peterson was born on September 25, 1928, on the family farm west of Viborg. His parents were Arthur and Marie Peterson. He attended school in Viborg.

On October 1, 1950, he was married to Margaret Petersen in Viborg. He served four years in the United States Navy during the Korean War. He then returned to the family farm where he lived and operated a dairy operation until his death. He passed away October 26, 1990, at Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg after reaching the age of 62 years.

Herbert was an active member of the United Methodist Church of Viborg, a lifetime member of the National Brown Swiss Association, and a member and past commander of VFW Post #7025. He had served on the Viborg School Board for nine years and was Secretary-Treasurer of the Rosehill Cemetery Association for many years.

He was preceded in death by his father, Arthur, and an infant sister.
