LAST RITES HELD FOR MRS. NELS M. HANSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Nels M. Hansen were held on Monday, August 17, at the Bethany Lutheran Church, with Dr. John M. Jensen officiating. Ray Bak sang "Sometime We'll Understand" and "Beyond The Sunset". Mrs. Leonard Holm was the organist. Pallbearers were Earl and Luverne Svendsen, Roland Petersen, Lawrence Johansen, Lester and Alvin Larson. Interment was at Rosehill cemetery.

Mrs. Nels M. Hansen, nee Emma Larsen, was born Oct. 22, 1888, in Yankton County on her parents' homestead into a family of eight children. She received her education in the Yankton County schools. On Nov. 7, 1905, she was married to Nels M. Hansen. They made their home on farms west of Viborg. Five children were born to them: Gladys, Edwin, Duane and Luverne, and one who died in infancy.

Two years ago they retired and moved to Viborg.

Mrs. Hansen passed away by a heart attack on August 14 at the Viborg Hospital. One son, Luverne, preceded her in death in 1949.

She leaves to mourn her passing, her husband, Nels M. Hansen, Viborg, S. Dak., one daughter, Mrs. Marvin Johnson of Viborg, and two sons, Edwin Hansen of Chancellor, S. Dak., and Duane Hansen of Viborg, and three grandchildren. She also leaves one sister, Mrs. Soren Jensen, Fairfax, S. Dak., and two brothers, Andrew V. Larsen, Viborg, and James Petersen of Luck, Wis., and other relatives and friends.
