FUNERAL SERVICES HELD SUNDAY FOR MARINUS HANSEN

Funeral services for Marinus "Shorty" Hansen, who died Thursday as the result of a car-train collision in Viborg, were held at Spring Valley Lutheran Church on Sunday, March 26, with Pastor Edward Nervig officiating. Mrs. Dennis Sletten was the organist, and soloist was Pastor Noel Vold. Pallbearers were Roy Hansen, Merle Hansen, Leo Hansen, Wayne Helgager, O'Neil Nielsen, and Harland Danielsen. Interment was in Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery.

Marinus "Shorty" Hansen was born June 3, 1894, to Mads and Bertha Hansen in Gann Valley, South Dakota. He passed away March 23, 1972 at McKennan Hospital in Sioux Falls at the age of 77 years, 9 months and 20 days.

Marinus farmed and worked in Turner County most of his life. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

He was preceded in death by his parents, three brothers and one sister.
