Funeral Services Held For Gerald Kropuenske

Funeral services were held on Thursday, January 15, 1987 at Spring Valley Lutheran Church at Viborg for Gerald F. Kropuenske, who died on January 12, 1987. Rev. Miles Nysetvold officiated at the services. Mrs. Dennis Sletten was organist; and Darrell Christensen was soloist. Pallbearers were Noble Odland, Darrell Kropuenske, Mark Weier, Harold Petersen, Don Beynon and Allen Pearson. He was laid to rest in the Spring Valley Cemetery.

Gerald Kropuenske was born January 23, 1915 on a homestead near Centerville in Turner County to parents C. Henry and Frederika (Mettler) Kropuenske and entered into death on January 12, 1987 at the age of 71 years, 11 months and 19 days.

Gerald grew up in the Centerville community and later married Margaret Sikkink on February 14, 1943 in the First English Lutheran Parsonage near Centerville. After their marriage the couple farmed in the Centerville-Viborg area and at the time of his death resided on a farm north of Viborg.

Gerald was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith at First English Lutheran Church near Centerville and was presently a member of Spring Valley Lutheran Church near Viborg.

Gerald was a beloved husband, father, and grandfather and will be
