#### OBITUARY

Thursday, November 2nd, the funeral of Anders Andersen took place from the West Swan Lake Lutheran church, Rev. Th. N. Jersild officiating. Anders Andersen was born in Vensyssel, Denmark, where he grew into manhood. He was enrolled as soldier and fought in the war of 1864, and for his bravery received a medal of honor. October 2nd, 1861, he was married to Ane Margrethe Jorgensen. Their matrimony was blessed with five sons of which one is dead, but four are still living and they together with their mother mourn the loss of a beloved father and husband. In 1884 Andersen with his family immigrated to America and they came to Molan, S. D., where they have lived 8 years. In 1892 they took homestead in Buffalo county, S. D. In 1910 they moved to Turner county. Here Andersen built a home on his oldest son's farm and lived there with his wife and youngest son until his death. In 1911 he and his wife celebrated their golden wedding. He was 80 years, 3 months and 10 days old when he died, November 28th, 1915. Blessed be his memory.
