Mrs. Margrethe Hansen Rites Held On Monday

Funeral services for Mrs. Margrethe Hansen, who passed away last Friday, were held at the Spring Valley Lutheran Church on Monday afternoon, May 5th, Rev. H. S. Madsen officiating. Mrs. Madsen was organist and the church chorus sang "My Faith Looks Up To Thee", at the prayer service at the farm home, and at the church sang "And Now We Must Bid One Another Farewell", "Safe In The Arms Of Jesus" and "Abide With Me".

Lonning, Parker, Melvin of Hurley, and one daughter who died in infancy.

Mrs. Hansen passed away on the morning of May 2, 1958, at the age of 73 years, 11 months and 14 days. Her husband, one daughter, one grand-daughter, her parents, two half-brothers and two half-sisters preceded her in death.
