FUNERAL SERVICES HELD SATURDAY FOR CHRISTINE JORGENSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. H. P. Jorgensen were held on Saturday, Nov. 8, 1975, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg with Pastor Donald Love officiating. Organist was Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen and special music was by Vernon Andersen and the Spring Valley Lutheran Ladies Chorus. Pallbearers were Glen Jorgensen, Lyle Jorgensen, Larry Jorgensen, Gene Jorgensen, Harold Jorgensen, and Wayne Jorgensen. Interment was in Bethania Cemetery.

Christine Rasmussen Jorgensen was born in Holbeck, Denmark, April 21, 1888.

She was united in marriage to Hans Peter Jorgensen on Jan. 6, 1910, at Parker, South Dakota. They farmed in the Viborg area until moving into Viborg in 1950. They celebrated their Golden Anniversary in 1960. Hans passed away July 3, 1965.

In 1968 Christine flew to Denmark to visit her brothers and sisters whom she had not seen for fifty-eight years.

Christine was a member of Our Savior's Lutheran congregation.

She is survived by three sons: Orvald of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, Arnie of Viborg, South Dakota, and Elmer of Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Also surviving are ten grandchildren (one grandchild passed away before her), 34 great-grandchildren, and one great-great grandson.
