Camilla Gudrun Hansen was born in Horsens, Denmark, May 5, 1885 and departed this life January 3, 1931, at the age of forty-five years, seven months and twenty-eight days.

She was married on September 26, 1905 to Lars C. Rold, the young people making their home in their native country until 1914, when they emigrated to America; remaining here until 1919 when they returned to Denmark for a visit, and remaining there three years. They returned to America in 1922, coming to Wa-

konda, South Dakota, which place has been their residence since with the exception of about a year when they lived at Viborg.

There are left to mourn her departure, her husband and their adopted son, Bjorne; her father, and three brothers and two sisters living in the the old country; three nephews; Vernon Rold of Viborg, Christ Rold of Pontiac, Michigan and Einar Lauritsen of Vermillion.

Mrs. Rold was confirmed into the Lutheran faith when a child, and remaned faithful adherent thereto until her death. She was a member of the Rebekah lodge, and of other local church and social organizations.

Funeral services were held Monday of the week at Wakonda with Rev. R. M. Powers officiating, and at Viborg at the North Lutheran church with Rev. E. M. Nielsen officiating. Burial was made west of town with the Rebekahs in charge of the service.
