Funeral services for John Leslie Anderson were held Monday, Jan. 13, at Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg, S. Dak., with Rev. Noel Vold officiating. Mr. Anderson was an active member of Bethany Lutheran Church, having served as council member for two terms.

He passed from this life Jan. 8, 1969.
