FUNERAL SERVICES HELD WEDSDAY FOR CHRIS C. ANDERSON

Funeral services for Chris C. Anderson were held from the Bethany Lutheran Church, Viborg, on Wednesday, June 19, 1974. Pastor Virgil White officiated. Organist was Mrs. James Oakland and soloist was Mrs. Delano Christensen who sang "How Great Thou Art". Pallbearers were: Newton Jensen, Delmar Jensen, Richard Spomer, Edward Christensen, Leo Reiser and Delmar Andersen. Interment was in Bethania Cemetery.

A prayer service was held at the Fraternal Funeral Home on Tuesday evening.

Chris C. Anderson was born on July 10, 1883, to Anton and Karen Anderson in Thisted, Denmark. Chris passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital on June 17 at the age of 80 years, 11 months, and 7 days.

At the age of 18, he came to America. He enlisted in the United States Army during the first World War and became an American citizen.

On March 18, 1920, he was united in marriage to Marie Jensen. Most of their married life was spent on a farm near Viborg. In 1952 they moved to Yankton where he was employed as maintenance man for Yankton College until retiring in 1959, and they then moved into Viborg.

Chris was a member of the Bethany Congregation.

One son, Leslie, preceded him in death.

He is survived by his wife, Marie; five daughters: Olga (Mrs. Chester Storgaard) of Irene, South Dakota, Ruby (Mrs. Harold Nielsen) of Egan, South Dakota, Ardell (Mrs. Curtis Kelly) and Helen (Mrs. Alfred Christopherson) both of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and Crystal (Mrs. Jack O'Malley) of Yankton, South Dakota; and one son, Merle, of Sioux Falls, South Dakota; 16 grandchildren, 21 great-grandchildren; and one brother and one sister in Denmark.
