Alfred Eugene Jensen was born June 4th, 1892 at Viborg, S. D. and died at his home southeast of New Underwood, after a protracted illness on February 14th, 1933 at the age of 40 years, 8 months and ten days.

He grew to manhood at Viborg and received his education in Valley Springs Township, Turner County.

On July 20th, 1918 he was united in marriage to Mae J. Larsen and to this union seven children were born: Faye Jean, Leila Beatrice, Carol Lorraine, Alvine Vingill, Ardella Mae, Eugene Laverne and Arlin James. The two latter died in infancy.

Soon after his marriage a home was established in Yankton County where the family resided for five years. Then they moved to Viborg taking up residence there for six years. In March 1930 they occupied a farm three miles west of New Underwood and lived there for two years. In 1932 they moved to their present home 18 miles south east of New Underwood.

Deceased leaves to mourn his loss, besides his widow and five children, his father and mother, Mrs. Carl A. Jensen, Viborg; two brothers, Leonard Jensen, Hurley, S.
