## H. WARREN BROCKMUELLER

H. Warren Brockmueller, 85, of Irene, SD died Wednesday, December 8, 2010 at Avera Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton, SD.

Funeral services were held Monday, December 13, 2010 at Calvary Lutheran Church in Irene. Burial followed in Turkey Valley Lutheran Cemetery, rural Irene.

Warren was born February 4, 1925 on the family farm near Irene, to Henry and Christine (Nielsen) Brockmueller. He grew up in the Irene area and attended Plainview Country School and later Irene High School. He was drafted in 1944 and served in the United States Army during World War II. Following his service came one of his proudest moments. When he was offered the opportunity to serve as a guard to General Douglas MacArthur, but chose not to take the assignment.

Warren returned to Irene after his military service and farmed

in the Irene Community until his retirement in 1990. He married Maxine Madsen on August 26, 1949 at Bethany Lutheran Church in Viborg, SD.

Warren enjoyed animals, especially dogs. He had a love for farming and also enjoyed hunting and fishing.

He was a member of Calvary Lutheran Church, VFW Post #791 in Yankton, and American Legion Hall Thompson Post #193 in Irene. He also served on the Turkey Valley Lutheran

Church Board and Mayfield School Board for several years.

Survivors include his wife Maxine of Irene, three sons; Steve (Jean) Brockmueller of Sioux Falls, SD, Craig (Kelly) Brockmueller of Pierre, SD and Scot (Vicki) Brockmueller of Irene, seven grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
