She married Everett Nelson on March 12, 1928. They made Viborg their home until about 2 years ago at which time they moved to Phoenix, Ariz., and lived there until August 15th when they moved to Kansas City, Mo.

Mrs. Nelson underwent brain surgery which she did not survive, and passed away Monday, Oct. 23, at the age of 70 years, 6 months and 11 days.
