FUNERAL SERVICES HELD THURSDAY FOR MRS. WOODBURY

Funeral services for Mrs. Christine Woodbury were conducted at the Wass Chapel in Centerville on Thursday, Aug. 21st. Rev. Oswald Elbe officiated. Mrs. Robert Fisher was the soloist and Mrs. Milton Wass was the organist. Pallbearers were, Clarence Jepsen, Dale Olson, Leonard Bertrand, Bud Person, Pershing Sylliaasen, and Elwyn Halsted. Interment was in Evergreen Cemetery, Hurley.

Christine Madsen was born Oct. 24, 1894, in Denmark, the daughter of Mads and Bertha Johanason Madsen, and passed away Aug. 17, 1975, at the age of 80 years, nine months and 23 days.

During her childhood, she immigrated to the United States with her parents who settled in the Viborg area. On Feb. 20, 1919, she was married to Lucian Albert Woodbury. The couple farmed near Centerville until 1948 when they moved into town. After the death of her husband in 1968, Mrs. Woodbury continued to live in Centerville until three years ago when she moved to Viborg. She was a member of the Seventh Day Adventist Church at Hurley.

Surviving are two daughters, Anna (Mrs. Wilfred Doty) of Wakonda and Bertha (Mrs. Duane Garvey) of Yorba Linda, Calif.; one brother, Chris Madsen of Aurora, Colo.; two sisters, Mrs. Marie Person of Viborg and Mrs. Anna Ambrasen of Dodge City, Kan.; four grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
