Obituary

MRS. H. M. ANDERSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. H. M. Andersen were held last Thursday at the Baptist Church with Rev. Shellhouse officiating. Rev. A. P. Nielsen of the Turkey Valley Baptist Church also spoke at the services.

Amalie Marie Kurtze Andersen was born December 31, 1869 at Lillesand, Norway to Martha and Albert Eversen Kurtze. She had five sisters and two brothers. Her early girlhood was spent in Lillesand. Rest of the time, until coming to the United States in 1906, she spent in Lillesand and Oslo except for seasons when she traveled with her father who was a Captain of an ocean freighter. She joined the Baptist Church in Norway in 1889.

On May 4th, 1906, at the Logan Square Baptist Church, Chicago she was married to Hans Martin Andersen. Two daughters were born to the Andersens, one died in infancy and Ingrid Margot Jeffrey.

Before moving to Viborg in the year 1920, Mr. and Mrs. Andersen lived at La Crosse, Wis., Dell Rapids, S. D., Artichoke, Minn., and Berton, S. D. At these places Mr. Andersen served as Pastor of the Baptist Church.

Mrs. Andersen became ill in February of this year after having had poor health for a year. She died on Sunday evening, July 18, 1943 at ten o'clock. Her age was 73 years, 6 months and 18 days.
