Carl A. Jensen was born August 23rd, 1867 at Stulstead, Denmark. In the year 1869 he came to America with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jens Christian Jensen who settled in Benton County, Iowa. In the year 1871 the family moved to Turner County, Dakota Territory and Homesteaded Northeast Quarter of Section 24 in Spring Valley township. They came all the way by ox teams. This homestead has remained in the family to this date.

He died suddenly from heart failure at the home of his son, Leonard on Saturday, March 25th, 1933, at the age of 65 years, 7 months and two days.

On August 25th, 1891 he was united in marriage to Anne Flyger and to this union nine children were born, seven of whom are living as follows:

Leonard L. Jensen of Hurley; Mrs. Vigeland of Cilverton, Oregon; Mrs. Jake Schooley of Volin; Mrs. Chris H. Larsen, of Hurley; Mrs. Andrew Johnson Jr., of Viborg; Mrs. Chris E. Andersen of Freeman; and Walter E. Jensen of New Underwood, S. D. Two

sons Alfred E. at the age of 40 years and Clarence D. at the age of 19 years, preceded him in death.

Surviving his are his wife, 7 children, 27 grandchildren of which he was very fond, two brothers, Johan Jensen and Jens G. Jensen and one sister, Mrs. J. P. Peterson. He grew to manhood in Turner County; farmed quite extensively for many years. He was always hard working and industrious; highly respected by his family and friends.
