Graveside services for Mrs. Annie Louise Christensen, 81, were held on Friday at Mt. Angeles Memorial Park in Port Angeles, Wash., with Pastor Rudolph Bloomquist of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church officiating. Arrangements were by Ridgeview Funeral Chapel.

Mrs. Christensen, who lived at 821 W. Sixth St., Port Angeles, Wash., died in that city on Tuesday. She was born Jan. 31, 1893, in Denmark, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Jens P. Nielsen.

She and Carl Christensen were married Jan. 31, 1910, in Parker, S. D. He died in 1961. She came to South Dakota from Denmark at the age of 12 and lived in South Dakota before moving to Port Angeles in 1944.
