Lyle Andal was born March 15, 1921, in Hooker, SD, to parents Oscar and Clara (Anderson) Andal. He died October 19, 2003, at the Good Samaritan Center in

Centerville, South Dakota, at the age of 82 years, 7 months, and 4 days.

Lyle attended District #42 school, Viborg, SD, and graduated from the 8th grade in May of 1935. He was inducted into the United States Army in August of 1942, at Fort Leavenworth, KS. He served as a machine gunner, transport truck driver, and a military policeman. Lyle returned to the Centerville area after being honorably discharged from the Army. He married Annabelle Carlson on September 5, 1954. The couple farmed in the Viborg, Irene, and Centerville areas. Lyle retired from farming in 1977 and moved into Centerville. He worked as a custodian at Scandia Lutheran Church for 16 years and drove a bus for the Centerville School District. Lyle also took care of Riverview Cemetery in the summertime.

Lyle was baptized and confirmed at Bethlehem Lutheran Church and later became a member at Scandia Lutheran Church.

He was preceded in death by his parents, son Kevin, five brothers, and one sister.

Among those who survive and gratefully shared his life are his wife Annabelle of Centerville; two sons: Luther and wife Becky of Kissimmee, FL and Colin and wife Young of Wagner, SD; three daughters: Dawn Coggins and husband Paul of Beresford, Denise Snoozy and husband Tom of Lennox, and Cindy Jeitz and husband Don of Centerville; 21 grandchildren, 4 great grandchildren; brother Ellsworth Andal and wife Marlys of Tea, SD, two sisters: Fern Jensen of Viborg, SD and Arlet Moen of Viborg, SD; and many nieces, nephews, relatives and friends.

Services for Lyle Andal were held on Thursday, October 23, at Scandia Lutheran Church, Centerville, with burial at Riverview Cemetery, rural Centerville.
