## LAST RITES HELD FOR OSCAR HELGAGER

Funeral services for Oscar P. Helgager were held Wednesday afternoon, Sept. 16th, at 2 o'clock, from Our Redeemer's Lutheran Church. Rev. Floyd Bacon officiated. Organist was Mrs. Andrew Wek and Curtis Anderson was soloist. Pallbearers were Norman O. Nielsen, Dennis Helgager, Ralph Anderson, Harland Danielsen, Leo Hansen, Leroy Sorensen. Interment was at Bang Cemetery.

Oscar P. Helgager was born February 8, 1901, in Turner County to Hans and Minnie Helgager. He was baptized March 17, 1901, at Bang Lutheran Church and confirmed July 8, 1917, at a Midway Parish confirmation service in Bethlehem Lutheran Church.

On February 24, 1925, he was united in marriage to Daisey V. Hanson in Spring Valley Lutheran Church. To this union three children were born: Ray O. Helgager of Aberdeen, Charlotte Nelson of Lead, and Wayne of Viborg.

Oscar departed this life on Sunday, September 13, in his home at the age of 63 years, 7 months and 5 days.

Preceding him in death were his parents, one brother, Clarence, and four sisters, Clara, Nettie, Ida and Hannah.

Surviving him is his wife and children; three brothers, Ben of Hurley, S. D., Arthur of Sioux Falls, S. D., and Lloyd of Encino, Calif.; four sisters, Pearl Boe and Alma Vogland, both of Yankton, S.
