John Pott died at his home near Hooker last Saturday afternoon, Nov. 17th, aged 57 years, 6 months and 27 days. He was a native of Holland, and came to this country in the early days, settling on his homestead, where he had ever since resided, in May 1876. He was one of the active forces in the development of the country, always a good citizen and friend. He was a member of the Reformed church. He leaves a wife, one brother, three sons and three daughters to mourn his loss. He had been in poor health for the past year, but was able to be up and about until a few days before his death. The funeral was held at noon today, at the home, interment being made on the home farm, beside the parents of the deceased.
