MRS. CARL JENSEN

Mrs. Carl Jensen was born in Justad Sogn, Jylland, Denmark, Feb. 22, 1855, where she was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, to which she remained faithful until her death.

In 1883 she, with her husband Mr. Carl Jensen, and their two oldest boys Jens and Peter left Denmark and came to Turner County, S. D., where they took up farming and Mrs. Jensen lived on the one and same farm for 53 years.

Ten children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Jensen of which two died in infancy. The eight living in this community they are:

Jens P. Jensen of Irene; Peter M. Jensen of Irene; Mrs. Charlie Andersen, Freeman; Mrs. M. J. Madsen, Irene; Mr. Even Jensen, Viborg; Mr. Freddie Jensen, Freeman; Mr. Charlie Jensen, Hurley; Mr. Harvey Jensen, Hurley. These together with sons and daughters-in-law and three sisters namely: Mrs. Andrew Christensen; Mrs. Chris Overgaard and Mrs. Lars Hansen are left to mourn her death. She also leaves 2 grandchildren and 20 great grandchildren. Mr. Carl Jensen preceded Mrs. Jensen into death Aug. 28, 1913.

Mrs. Jensen passed away at her home peacefully after a long and hard sickness on Feb. 18, 1936. She being 80 years 11 months and 27 days. She was buried on her birthday, Feb. 22, at Spring Valley Lutheran cemetery. The Rev. N. P. Nielsen having charge of the service.
