LAST RITES HELD MONDAY, JANUARY 6 FOR MARTIN HEIM

Funeral services for Martin Heim, who passed away suddenly on Thursday, Jan. 2, were held on Monday, Jan. 6, 1964, from Bethany Lutheran Church with Rev. G. E. Udem officiating. Music was furnished by Mrs. Delano Christensen, Mrs. Arnie Sorensen and Miss Rhoda Gaddis. Martin Heim, son of Mathias and Marith Heim, was born August 30, 1887, and attended school near Montevideo, Minn. He passed away Jan. 2, 1964. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

Mr. Heim was united in marriage to Petra Helgemo on Nov. 7, 1907. To this union eight children were born: Marvin of Aberdeen; Lester of Seattle, Wash.; Clifford of Yankton; Arthur who died in infancy; Ruby (Mrs. S. W. Bradley) of Alpine, N. Mr. Heim was engaged in farming until 1946 when he and his wife retired to Swan Lake.
