FUNERAL SERVICES HELD MONDAY FOR MARY CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Mary Christensen were held on Monday, Nov. 25, 1974, from the Viborg United Methodist Church with Pastor Ralph Dunn officiating. Organist was Mrs. Fred Flyger and soloist was Mrs. Robert Ward. Pallbearers were: Sam Anderson, Verdel Anderson, Lyle Christensen, Robert Johnson, Jimmy Christensen, and Marvin Christensen. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery, Viborg, South Dakota.

Mary Johnson was born April 6, 1888, in Turner County, South Dakota. She was united in marriage to Samuel E. Christensen, September 22, 1909, at Viborg. They farmed in the Viborg community until retiring into Viborg in 1940. Sam passed away in August of 1968. Mary resided in the Hilltop Nursing Home in Parker for a time, and then moved into the Pioneer Memorial Nursing Home where she was residing at the present time. On Sunday, Nov. 17, Mary became ill and she passed away early Saturday morning, Nov. 23, 1974, at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg.
