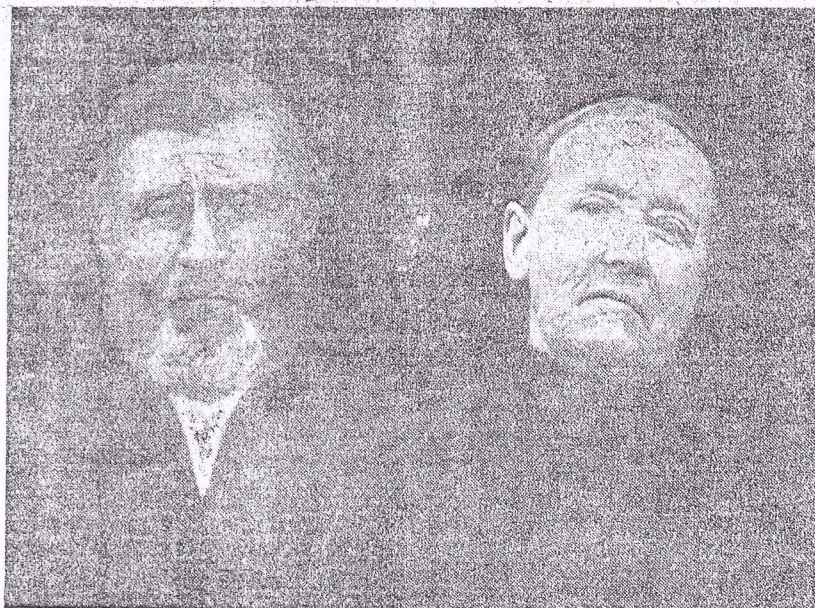

#### OBITUARY

Sunday, September 12th, Peder Nielsen was laid to rest at the Spring Valley Lutheran cemetery. The funeral took place from the Spring Valley Lutheran church, where a great number of friends and relatives were present. Rev. Th. N. Jersild officiated.

Peder Nielsen was born in Ugilt Sogn, Denmark, Nov. 20th, 1833 and died at his home near Viborg Sept. 9th, 1920, reaching the high age of 86 years, 9 months and 20 days.

Mr. Nielsen had been married twice. In 1855 he was united in holy wedlock to Karen Marie Thomsen, and after her death he married Dorteia Marie Nielsen, who survives him.

In 1884 Peder Nielson immigrated to America and arrived at Chicago in the month of May, but in the fall of the same year they moved to Turner county, where they have had their home ever since.

Mr. and Mrs. Nielsen were blessed with a large family. He was the

father of 16 children, of which six have gone to the land beyond. But besides his beloved wife he leaves 10 children: Mrs. H. A. Sorensen, Viborg; C. T. Nielsen and Sine Nielson who live in Denmark; N. G. Nielsen, Tyler, Minn.; T. C. Nielsen, Viborg; J. C. Nielsen, Stockholm, S. D.; Mrs. Martin Larsen, Hurley, S. D.; Sixtus Nielsen, Hurley, S. D.; Albert Nielsen, Viborg, S. D., and Thorvald Nielsen, Manitou, Colo. 36 grand children and 16 great grandchildren mourn the loss of a good husband and a beloved father, grand father and great grand father.

Peder Nielsen was an honest, upright, peaceable man, who will be missed by all who knew him.
