Services for Kenneth M. Happy 32, of Providence, R.I., formerly of Sioux City, were held at 9 a.m. Wednesday, Aug. 20th at Our Savior's Lutheran Church. The Rev. Krishen Persaud officiated.

Graveside rites were held at 11:30 a.m. Wednesday at Bethany Cemetery, Viborg, S.D. The Rev. Norman Wahl officiated.

Mr. Happy was the victim of a shotgun slaying late Thursday in his Providence apartment.

He was born Dec. 15, 1947, in Detroit, Mich. He was reared in Sioux City and was salutatorian of his 1966 Heelan High School graduating class. He graduated from Michigan State University in 1970, moved to the east coast in 1970, and received a master's degree in economics in 1972 from Brown University in Providence. He had been teaching and was a lecturer in economics at Southeastern Massachusetts University at North Dartmouth, Mass.

He is survived by his mother, Mrs. Charlotte Happy of Sioux City, and a sister, Mrs. Michael (Cheryl) Horn of Dubois, Wyo.
