Last Rites For Paul J. Paulsen

Funeral services for Paul J. Paulsen were held on Wednesday afternoon at the Bethany Lutheran Church, with Rev. K. R. Jensen officiating. Pallbearers were Alfred Knudsen, Peter Langland, Harry Long, Elmer Andersen, Charlie Jensen and Hans Skov. Interment was at the Spring Valley Lutheran Cemetery.

Paul J. Paulsen passed away at his home in Viborg last Saturday evening after an illness of about five months.

He was the son of Jens and Johanna Paulsen and was born in Turner County, South Dakota, October 2nd, 1891. Thus he was 62 years, 3 months, and 7 days when he passed away.

Paul spent his childhood and youth in his home county. On October 18th, 1911, he was united in marriage to Maggie Jorgensen, also of Turner County. Mr. and Mrs. Paulsen have made their home here since with the exception of five years in Montana.

To the Paulsens were born five boys. Two of them passed away in infancy. The others are: Richard of Port Townsend, State of Washington; Royal of west of Viborg; and Ralph of Escondido, California. These sons and their families, with Mrs. Paulsen, mourn the passing of a good husband and father. Nine grandchildren also mourn the passing of a loved grandfather. Four sisters also survive. Three sisters and one brother preceded him in death.

Before moving to Viborg, the Paulsens were members of the Spring Valley Lutheran Church. Since then they have been members of Bethany congregation.
