FUNERAL SERVICES HELD MONDAY FOR SARAH OVERGAARD

Funeral services for Sarah Christensen Overgaard were held on Monday, Aug. 22, 1977, from Our Savior's Lutheran Church, Viborg, with Pastor Donald Love officiating. Organist was Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen and soloist was Mr. Vernon Andersen. A hymn, "Abide With Me", was sung by the congregation.
