Chresten Jensen was born in Denmark, (Stenderup Sogn) near Horsrud, May 20th, 1839, and passed away at the home of his daughter, Mr. and Mrs. John Peterson, northwest of Viborg on Monday, March 16th, 1925 being at the time of his death 85 years, 9 month and 26 days of age.

Mr. Jensen was baptized and later confirmed in the Lutheran church, and in November, 1868 he was united in marriage to Miss Sine Steen of Jellinge, near Vejle, Denmark, who became to him a good and faithful helpmate in building up a home. Six children were born to this union, three of them having preceeded their father in death. In February, 1902 the mother also died. Home had then lost its attraction for Mr. Jensen, and in the fall of the same year he immigrated to this country and settled down in this neighborhood, where he found a new home with his daughter and son-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. John Petersen, and where he lived until the time of his death.

Three children of Mr. Jensen's live to mourn the loss of a dear father. They are: Mrs. John Petersen, Viborg; Mrs. D. E. Hicks, Centerville and Mr. Niels Jensen, Viborg as well as five grand children and four great grand children.

Funeral services are being held from the home and the South Lutheran church this afternoon and the remains were laid to rest in the Rose Hill cemetery. The funeral services being conducted by Rev. J. J. Lera-ger.
