LLOYD A. LARSON

Funeral services for Lloyd Ardell Larson were held at Westminster, Calif., on Sept. 21, 1967, at the Peek Family Colonial Funeral Home. Pastor Robert Larsen of Grace Lutheran Church officiated. Lloyd Ardell Larson, son of Mrs. Bertha Larson and the late Emil Larson, was born on Jan. 13, 1924, at Carthage, S. Dak. He graduated from Volin High School in 1942.

On Feb. 26, 1943, Lloyd enlisted in the Army and served his country, receiving his honorable discharge June 10, 1945. Sgt. Larson received the Purple Heart for wounds received in Bleichammerer, Germany, on Dec. 26, 1944. He also received 2 Oak Leaf Clusters, 1 Star and the Good Conduct Medal.

Mr. Larson passed away at the Hoag Memorial Hospital at New Beach, Calif., Sept. 1967, at the age of 43 years, 8 months and 5 days after suffering a coronary hemorrhage.

Survivors include his wife, Florence; one daughter, Patricia Mack; one step-son, James W. Skeels; his mother, Mrs. Bertha Larson of Viborg; two brothers, Elrud and Vernell, and 3 step-grandchildren.

Interment was at the Good Shepherd Cemetery, Huntington Beach, Calif.
