Obituary of Mrs. John A. Petersen

Anna Jorgine Jensen was born at Bjornkjaer, near Horsens, Jutland in Denmark, on the 11th day of May, 1879. One of a family of six children. One sister and two brothers have preceeded her death. A brother, Nels K. Jensen, of Viborg, and Mrs. D. E. Hicks of Gibbon, Nebr., attended the funeral.

Anna Jensen was baptised, confirmed and married in the same church, the "Nebsager church" of the Danish State church.

On August 15, 1902 the marriage of Anna Jensen and Johanes Anton Peterson took place, and their wedding trip was their immigration to America, arriving Turner county, S. D., Sept. 10, 1902, where they spent all the years of their married life, the last 22 years on the farm where death claimed Mrs. Peterson on the 1st day of August, 1938, early in the morning. Mrs. Peterson reached the age of 59 years, months and 20 days.

Two children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Peterson. They are Mrs. Sena Hansen of Viborg and Miss Marian Peterson at home with the parents. Mr. Peterson, the children, the brother and sister, and a host of friends mourn the passing of Mrs. Peterson. Without becoming too personal, I think this remark may be permitted. Upon visiting the Peterson home one was always impressed by the tone of understanding and sympathy that prevailed which tended to characterize Mrs. Peterson as a woman of deep human wisdom. May we learn from her example and may God rest her in her new home.
