## OBITUARY

A. N. Apland was born June 14, 1852, in Norway. At the age of twelve he came to America with his parents who located in Polk County, Iowa.

In May 1874 he came to Dakota Territory. The following month he located on a homestead in Turner county.

On May 3rd, 1880, Mr. Apland was united in marriage to Chloe Potts and to them have been born nine children.

He served three terms in the state legislature, as representative from Turner county.

He was a member of the Lutheran church.

While living on the farm he engaged extensively in stock buying and in the fall of 1906 he, with his family moved to Viborg, S. D., where he continued in this business.

In the fall of 1910 he moved to Canistota, S. D.

Mr. Apland passed away the morning of March 23, 1931 at the Sioux Valley hospital, Sioux Falls at the age of 78 years, 9 months and 9 days.

His wife and three children preceded him in death.

Those left to mourn his loss are six children, Nels, Mabel, Lillian, Bertha, John and Charley and ten grand children, one brother, Henry Apland and two sisters, Mrs. P. D. Combs and Mrs. P. Skola of Sioux Falls.
