MRS. LUDVIG ANDERSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Ludvig Andersen were held on Tuesday afternoon at Our Savior's Lutheran Church, with Rev. Harald Ebsen officiating. Pallbearers were: Eskild C. Mrs. Ludvig Andersen was born Agnes Marie Jensen, daughter of Anders and Marie Jensen, on July 12th, 1886, at Sivdal, Denmark. She passed away at her home, following a lingering illness, on March 27, 1953, at the age of 66 years, 8 months, and 15 days.

In 1909, she came to the United States to make her home with the Lawrence Jacobsen family near Hurley. Two years later she was united in marriage to Ludvig Andersen. To this union nine children were born.

She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith, and was an active member of Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg.

Since coming to America, she has made her home in this community. In March, 1951, she and her husband retired from farming and moved to Viborg, where she resided until the time of her death.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Ludvig, a daughter, Astrid, her parents, two sisters and one brother.

In passing, she leaves to mourn, eight children: Ejner of Hurley, Vera (Mrs. Boyd Christensen) of Hurley, Herdis (Mrs. Raymond Almond) of Parker, Helga (Mrs. Wm. Eickel) of Parker, Ejler of Viborg, Arne of Sioux Falls, Leo of Hurley, Dagmar (Mrs. Duane Larsen) of Viborg, and 15 grandchildren.
