MRS. EVEN JENSEN RITES HELD TUESDAY

Funeral services for Mrs. Even Jensen were held Tuesday, March 26th, from the Hansen Funeral Home at Irene, and the Spring Valley Lutheran Church of Viborg with Rev. Gerhart Lingen officiating. A short prayer service was held at the funeral home with Mrs. Kenneth Knutson singing "No Disappointment in Heaven". The Ladies Chorus of the Church sang "Safe in the Arms of Jesus" and Mrs. Knutson singing "Does Jesus Care" at the church with Mrs. Orville Johnson furnishing the music.

Mrs. Rosie Jensen, nee Larsen, daughter of Lars and Hansina Larsen, was born Feb. 20, 1894, in Spring Valley Township, Turner County. She was baptized and confirmed into the Lutheran faith in the Spring Valley Lutheran Church.

On Dec. 17, 1913, she was united in marriage to Even Jensen. To this union was born one daughter, Verna, Mrs. LeRoy Hansen.

They spent the first 33 years on several farms in the surrounding community and the last 16 years at their present home near Irene.

She entered Sacred Heart Hospital March 16, 1963, after suffering a heart attack that morning and passed away Saturday morning, March 23, at 8 o'clock, at the age of 69 years, 1 month and 3 days.

She was preceded in death by her father, sisters Ida and Tena, and brother Louie. She is survived by her husband Even, daughter Verna and son-in-law, 3 grandchildren, 1 great-grandchild, her aged mother, Mrs. L. P. Larsen, sister Lillie, Mrs. Ole Eli of Irene, and brother Charley Larsen of Viborg.
