OBITUARY

Mrs. Marie Flyger died Aug. 27th, 1912. Mrs. Flyger was born in Aistrup Denmark, Jan. 3, 1836, where she lived with her parents til the fall of 1855, when she was united in marriage to John L. Flyger, with whom she immigrated to America in the year 1867. To this union was born 14 children of whom three survive her, Fred C. Flyger, Mrs. Carl A. Jensen and Mrs. Tillie Holm. She is also survived by a brother, C. Frederickson, of Sioux City, and a sister, Mrs. P. Lauritsen, of Viborg.

Her husband died July 21, 1894, since which time she has made her home with her son Fred C. Flyger. Early in life she began to seek the Saviour and put her trust in God. April 4, 1879, she was baptised and joined the Swan Lake Seventh Day Adventist church, of which she was a faithful member until her death.

The funeral was held today at 11 o'clock from Mrs. Holm's home and interment took place in the Adventist cemetery.

After a long, busy and useful life she died as she had lived—honored, trusted and loved. She reared her own monument while she lived in the hearts of all who knew her. Her life was completed if work all done and well done constitutes completion. Her Christian life was beautiful from its beginning to its close, and through all the vicissitudes and sorrows that she met in the way, her faith in God never wavered. But she has left us and soon the autumn leaves will fall upon another grave that hides from our sight all that is mortal of a true and noble woman.
