Gustave Adolph Hill was born March 4, 1913 to Joseph and Paulena Hill in rural Freeman community. He died at the age of 70 on April 11, 1983 at the Freeman Community Hospital.

He was baptized at the Bang Lutheran Church and confirmed in the Viborg Bethany Lutheran Church by pastor Hans Jersild.

He spent his early years living in Viborg and was graduated from the Viborg High School in 1933.

Life was never easy for Gustave as he lost his mother at the early age of four. He was a kind person and was willing to help others wherever he could.

He married Leila Georgeson on October 20, 1937. They farmed in the rural Freeman community for 37 years. Due to failing health he was forced to retire.

He was a member of the Bang Lutheran Congregation and had held positions on the church board there. His faith in God continued to grow during his illness.

Surviving are his wife, Leila; two sons, Thomas and Richard, Viborg, SD; two daughters, Paulette (Mrs. Anthony Homyk), Chicago, IL, and Lynette (Mrs. Wm. Dannenbring), Menno, SD; six grandchildren; one sister, Emma Georgeson of Yankton, SD; several nieces and nephews, and many friends.

He also has aunts, uncles and cousins living in Norway.
