LAST RITES HELD FOR MRS. A. CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Mrs. Axel P. Christensen, who died suddenly of a heart attack on Wednesday, Dec. 9th, were held at the Spring Valley Lutheran Church on Saturday afternoon, Dec. 12th, at 2:00 P. M. Rev. Orvis Hanson officiated. Two vocal selections were rendered: "Light In My Window" was sung by the Ladies Aid choir, and "The Lord's Prayer" by Ray Bak. Christine Nielsen, daughter of Nels and Ingrid Nielsen, was born in Agersun, Denmark, on May 7, 1899, and passed away suddenly of a heart attack on December 9, 1959, at the age of 60 years, 7 months and 2 days. Most of her life she resided in this community except for three years in Yankton, S. Dak.

On April 1, 1920, she was united in marriage to Axel Christensen. To this union four children were born: Virgil of Dell Rapids, S. D., Margie—Mrs. Loran Wiedmeier of Viborg, S. Dak., Darlene—Mrs. Delmer Wiedmeier of Menno, S. D., and Harley of Viborg, S. Dak.
