Funeral Services Held Here Saturday For Andrew Christopherson

Funeral services for Andrew Christopherson were held from Our Savior's Lutheran Church in Viborg on Saturday, Nov. 15, with Pastor Paul Petersen officiating. Organist was Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen and soloist was Vernon Andersen. Pallbearers were Jens Nielsen, Raymond Jespersen, Jens Jensen, Sam Jensen, Dwight Andersen and Carl Mikkelsen. Interment was in Rosehill Cemetery.

Andrew Christopherson was born on August 18, 1886, in Seretlev, Denmark. There he was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Church. In May, 1904, he immigrated to the United States, settling around Viborg.

On February 9, 1913, he was united in marriage to May Jensen. To this union six children were born. The couple farmed most of their married life and moved into their home in Viborg about 25 years ago.

Andrew Christopherson was a member of Our Saviors' Lutheran. He also held membership in the Danish Brotherhood Society.

On Wednesday, November 12, Andrew Christopherson passed away at the Pioneer Memorial Hospital in Viborg. He was preceded in death by two children who died in infancy; a son, Harry, who was fatally wounded in World War II; two brothers and one sister.

Besides his wife, May, he is survived by two sons, Earl of Irene and Ellwood of Hurley; one daughter, Viola, of Santa Ana, Calif.; one brother, Chris of Gulf Breeze, Florida; thirteen grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.
