## FUNERAL

Tena Anderson—nee Christenson was born near Beresford, South Dakota, February 10, 1883 and died September 21, 1934; her death resulted from an unavoidable automobile accident ten days prior to her death. During her early years she lived with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Jens Christenson, on the old home place south of Beresford, remaining there until she was united in marriage to David O. Anderson, December 10, 1902.

David and Tena settled on his parents homestead south of Alcester, continuing there until Mar. 1, 1919, when they removed to their own farm home just west of Viborg. To this union were born four sons, Rosslyn and Grover, who preceded their mother in death, while Oliver and Linden are with us today.

Mrs. Anderson was of a quiet, modest, retiring nature. She was more than ordinarily devoted to her husband and sons looking after their every need with great diligence. Her Christian experience was quiet and sincere and she rests with perfect confidence in the love of her Lord whom she served so faithfully. Throughout her last suffering she offered no protest and made no complaint and expressed a willingness to trust all to Him who knows how to do for the good of His children.

Mrs. Anderson leaves, as most intimate mourners her aged father now ninety-two years of age, to whom she has been so devoted, her husband, two sons and a brother besides a large circle of relatives and friends. She rests from her labors while we are left to carry on without her words of counsel and cheer, but we mourn not as those having no hope for we shall so be gathered to Him who has promised to come for His own.

Services were conducted at the home and in the Seventh-day Adventist church northwest of Viborg by the writer, assisted by Rev. Prewitt and C. Christensen. The sympathy of the community is with the family in this sad hour of sorrow.—J. W. Christian.
