EMIL HANSEN PASSES AFTER BRIEF ILLNESS

Emil Hansen was born March 9, 1866, in Denmark. He was baptized and joined the Baptist church near Viborg in 1886.

On May 31, 1892 he was united in marriage to Mary Hanson of Hooker, S. D. To this union four children were born. Emil Hansen immigrated to this country in the spring of 1887 and came to Viborg, S. D., where he resided until the summer of 1897, he and his family moved to Cass county, Minn., where they remained for six years then moved back to Turner county, S. D., where they remained until the spring of 1935 and then moved to Strandburg, S. D. His health began to fail a few years ago. In the evening of Jan. 24th he took seriously ill and early next morning he passed away at the age of 71 years, 10 months and 16 days.

He leaves his wife, four children, namely Hilbert of Labolt, S. D.; Mrs. Esther Luden, Centerville, S. D.; Ervin of Kent, Washington, and Mrs. Ethel Hilbrands of Strandburg, S. D. Two brothers, Harry and Martin of Motley, Minnesota, two sisters, Mrs. C. P. Christensen, Irene, S. D., and Mrs. J. P. Nelson of Viborg, S. D., and twelve grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at the church in Strandburg on Thursday and Saturday from the Funeral Home and Methodist church in Viborg. Rev. Kildal was the officiating pastor.

Interment was in Rose Hill Cemetery.
