Funeral Held For Marvin Peterson

Marvin N. Peterson, son of Jen Lawrence and Minnie (Nelson) Peterson, was born August 26, 1907, in Viborg, SD, where he grew up and graduated from Viborg High School in 1926. In 1927 he moved to Sioux Falls.

He was united in marriage with Marjorie Mae Johnson on May 25, 1936, at the First United Methodist Church parsonage in Sioux Falls.

During WW II Marv served in the U.S. Army. After his honorable discharge he returned to Sioux Falls.

Marv worked as a driver for Jack Rabbit Lines for 45 years, retiring in 1972. In 1969, he was honored as the Driver of the Year by the Associated Motor Carriers of South Dakota. At that time Marv had driven over 3,750,000 miles for Jack Rabbit without a chargeable accident.

He was a member of First United Methodist Church, the Knights of Pythias, Modern Woodmen of America and AARP.

Grateful for having shared his life are his wife, Marjorie M. Peterson, Sioux Falls; two brothers: Wayne E. Peterson, Viborg, and James L. Peterson, Rapid City; and a host of other relatives and friends.

He was preceded in death by his parents; three brothers: Melby, Reuben and Alvin; and two sisters: Vera Jensen and Mayme Flynn.
