Lloyd R. Knudson was born February 6, 1943 near Centerville, SD to parents Ralph and Carolyn (Nelson) Knudson and entered into death on August 30, 1998 at the Sioux Valley Hospice Cottage in Sioux Falls, SD, after a long battle with cancer at the age of 55 years, six months, and 24 days.

Lloyd attended grade school at Mt. Zion Country School. and graduated from Centerville High School in 1961. After graduation Lloyd continued farming with his dad until he started operating his own farm. On November 7, 1964 he married LeAnn Hagen of Beresford at the Lands Lutheran Church in rural Hudson, SD. After their marriage the couple operated a dairy and grain farm in the Centerville area.

Lloyd was baptized and confirmed at the Scandia Lutheran Church in Centerville where he was presently a member. He was an active member of the Farmers Lumber Yard Board of Directors and also served on the AMPI Board of Directors.

Lloyd was preceded in death by his mother Carolyn.
