Last Rites For P. C. Christensen Next Saturday

P. C. Christensen, retired Viborg businessman, died of a heart attack last Monday evening. He had been failing in health since he sold his Confectionary store last March, after being in business here in the same location for 42 years. Mr. and Mrs. Christensen had just recently moved into their new home erected on the east edge of town.

Funeral services will be held next Saturday afternoon, Feb. 21st, at Our Savior's Lutheran Church at 2:00 P. M., with Rev. Harald Ibsen officiating. The Viborg Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.

PETER C. CHRISTENSEN

Funeral services for Peter C. Christensen, who passed away on February 16th, were held at Our Savior's Lutheran Church on Monday, Feb. 23rd. Rev. Harald Ibsen officiated. Mrs. L. J. Rasmussen sang "My God and I" and "Come, Ye Disconsolate". Pallbearers were Ellsworth Christensen, Virgil Christensen, Dale Christensen, Russell Christensen, LeRoy Christiansen and Elmer Vik. Interment was at Rosehill Cemetery.

Peter C. Christensen, son of Christian and Christine Pedersen, was born in Ugilt, Sindal, Denmark, on September 27th, 1886, and passed away February 16th, 1953, at the age of 66 years, 4 months and 19 days. He was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

In 1903 he came to America and settled near Irene. He later came to Viborg, and in December, 1910, purchased a Confectionery Store which he retained until his retirement in March, 1952.

On November 11, 1915, he was united in marriage to Esther Hansen. To this union, seven children were born. They are, Emerall of Port Angeles, Wash., Carolyn (Mrs. Ralph Thogersen) of Los Angeles, Calif., Herbert of Seattle, Wash., Warren of Glendale, Calif., Elaine (Mrs. Omar Karp) of Centerville, S. Dak., Jean (Mrs. L. L. Braa) of Minneapolis, Minn., and Merritt, in the Navy, currently stationed at San Diego, Calif.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his loving wife, children, seven grandchildren, five brothers, Miller of Viborg, Viggo of Irene, Chris of Wakonda, and Alfred and Torvald of Denmark; and four sisters, Dagmar of Denmark, Mrs. Nels Christensen of Viborg, Katherine of Seattle, Wash., and Mrs. James Sanaker of Clear Lake, S. Dak. Also a host of other relatives and friends.

Mr. Christensen had been failing in health the past few years, but more seriously since he suffered a cerebral hemorrhage last April, very shortly after retiring from business. Another more serious hemorrhage, suffered on February 16, was the immediate cause of death.

P. C. Christensen was a kind and loving husband and father and a well-known and respected member of this community.
