## Obituary

MRS. CARL A. JENSEN

Anna Olena Flyger, daughter of John and Marie Flyger, was born at Lazerne, Iowa, March 29, 1869. In the year of 1878, she moved with her parents to Swan Lake, Dakota Territory.

On August 25, 1891, she was united in marriage to Carl A. Jensen. To this union nine children were born, six of whom are living, namely, Leonard L. Jensen of Hurley, Mrs. Hans Vigeland of Silverton, Ore., Mrs. Jake Schooley of Volin, Mrs. Chris H. Larson, Mrs. Andrew Johnson, and Mrs. Leon Wallace, all of Viborg. Her husband and three sons, Alfred, Clarence and Walter, preceded her in death.

Nine years ago, Mrs. Jensen suffered a light stroke, which left her in poor health. Since then she has made her home with her children and relatives, until seven months ago when she was taken to the Lutheran Home for the Aged in Sioux Falls where she passed away on November 6th, having reached the age of 77 years, 7 months, and 8 days. She leaves to mourn her passing, 6 children, 30 grandchildren, 15 great grandchildren, and many other relatives and friends.

Following a brief service at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Andrew Johnson, funeral services were held at the Seventh Day Adventist Church at Hurley on November 10, 1946, Elder H. H. Hare officiating. Interment was made in the family lot at the Adventist Cemetery, 6 miles Northwest of Viborg.

Pallbearers were six grandsons, Duane, Kermit and Dale Schooley, Donald Larson, Burnell and Delbert Johnson.
